This National Board Induction Program is applicable to all new National Board Members of AFL Masters Inc (AFLM).

Purpose of the AFLM National Board Induction Program

The purpose of this National Board Induction Program is to document a structured way of providing new board members with all the information and support they need to be confident and productive in their role. The aim is to help new members to understand the organisation, the environment in which it operates, and their role in making the organisation a success.

Timing

The induction plan is in place as soon as practical after a new AFLM National Board Member begins. Doing so presents a professional image of the organisation and is very reassuring for the new board member. A Director Induction Pack, which contains all the key documents required by AFL National Board members shall be produced.

Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the Chairperson to work through the induction pack with all new AFLM National Board members. In addition to familiarising the new National Board Member with the documents, the induction should be used to introduce them to the culture of AFL Masters and their role and responsibilities as a National Board Member. It may also involve identifying training and development needs to ensure the National Board Member can contribute effectively to the organisation.

Outline of the AFLM National Board Induction Program

The following table outlines suggested inclusions for the induction program for new AFLM National Board members; note the below items are to be presented and discussed at appointment.
